The Reverend Dr. D. Stuart Dunnan

Headmaster - St. James School, Hagerstown, Maryland

Reverend Dr. D. Stuart Dunnan was appointed headmaster of Saint James School in June of 1992. Father Dunnan holds bachelor's and master's degrees in history from Harvard University and master's and doctoral degrees in theology from Oxford University in England.

Rector - Saint Paul's Episcopal Church, San Rafael, California

Reverend Christopher Martin has been Rector of St. Paul's since 2004. Martin was educated at Yale University, where he completed both his B.A. and his Master of Divinity degree. He leads a national reform movement called The Restoration Project.

Senior Fellow - Trinity Institute for Spiritual Formation, Greenwich, Connecticut
Dr. Hillary Bercovici is a life-long summer resident of Watch Hill and has been in parish ministry since 1984. He holds an interdisciplinary PhD. in Psychology and Theology and also maintains a part-time practice of pastoral psychotherapy.
- July 22 **The Reverend Dr. Nancy S. Taylor**
Senior Pastor - Old South Church, Boston, Massachusetts
Reverend Dr. Nancy S. Taylor has served since 2005 as the 20th Senior Minister and chief executive officer of Old South Church. Dr. Taylor studied at Macalester College (B.A), Yale Divinity School (M. Div.), and Chicago Theological Seminary (D. Min).
- July 29 **The Reverend Alice Trowbridge**
Pastor, Caldwell Presbyterian Church, Lake George, New York
Reverend Trowbridge is Pastor of Caldwell Presbyterian Church. She earned a B.A. in Art History from Occidental College and a Master of Divinity from Union Theological Seminary. Upon graduation from college, Alice worked at Christie's Auction House and served in the U.S. Peace Corps in Mali, Africa.
- August 5 **The Reverend Dr. Casey Baggott**
Executive Minister - Community Church of Vero Beach, Vero Beach, Florida
Reverend Dr. Casey Baggott serves as Executive Minister at the Community Church of Vero Beach. She has an undergraduate degree in psychology from the University of Minnesota, a Master of Divinity degree from United Seminary of the Twin Cities, and a Doctor of Ministry from the Graduate Theological Foundation.
- August 12 **The Reverend Dr. Robert T. Baggott**
Senior Minister - Community Church of Vero Beach, Vero Beach, Florida
Dr. Bob Baggott is the Senior Minister at the Community Church of Vero Beach. Dr. Baggott was one of twelve clergy chosen to be included in the inaugural Robert Schuler Institute of Preaching in 1990 and gave the Opening Invocation for the Congress of the United States.

Priest Associate - Christ Church Greenwich, Greenwich, Connecticut
Reverend Terry L. Elsberry retired in 2017 after 23 years as Rector of St. Matthew's and St. Mary's Churches in Bedford, NY. Elsberry has twice been part of the Oxford Round Table, an international colloquium for government leaders and academics.
